WA TOURISM AWARDS FINALISTS ANNOUNCED!

Finalists in the 2009 WA Tourism Awards were announced last night at simultaneous events held at Fremantle Prison and Xanadu Winery in Margaret River.

Over 250 tourism industry guests gathered across the two venues to hear the announcement of finalists in the 29 categories of the Awards.
